

OUR RESPONSE TO EARTHQUAKES IN HAITI

By now we all know what terrible events have taken place in Haiti during the past week. Many reporters on the scene have described it as "**horrific**" and "**almost more than can be imagined**". Can you place yourself in a scenario where almost every building in the community practically exploded around you, people are dazed, injured, bleeding, wandering, crying, some buried or partially buried in the rubble of what used to be businesses, government buildings and homes? You can't get home or reach your family because of the rubble in the streets, all the communication systems are down and there is no FEMA or well-organized relief effort to help you.

How can we help?

FIRST - PRAY! Allow the Holy Spirit to lead your prayers for our brothers and sisters in Haiti.

SECOND: A 40" shipping container will be on the Gloria Dei Church property in Davie, FL until Feb. 1 collecting Relief Supplies. We are collecting the following: **Bottled water, canned food in pop top cans, antibiotic ointment, dishwashing liquid, soap, washcloths, hand towels, toothbrushes, toothpaste, baby formula in pop top cans, shovels, buckets, bed sheets, clothing (boxed and labeled).**

THIRD: *Any and all funds collected will be used solely for disaster relief, to purchase needed supplies, medicine or transportation. Distribution of relief supplies will be through our accountable partners on the ground in Haiti.*

MISSION: HAITI is an IRS recognized 501(c) 3 tax exempt organization. All donations are tax deductible and you will receive a tax receipt and updates on the relief effort.
